Town Board meeting held May 13, 2015 cont'd.

Discussion:

Supervisor Marcinkowski updated the Board about the cemetery. Mr. Marcinkowski told the Board that Tony Hartle quit on April 15th, 2015 and told Scott Booth it was because the Supervisor cut his hours. A new employee was hired and Dave Ebbrecht from the Highway has been opening graves. The Town employees will all be working in the cemetery on May 20th to make sure it is ready for Memorial Day weekend.

Mihail Galeria told the Board that he purchased land on Hyde Lake Road and would like to build a house on the land. As of now the section of road is seasonal and his bank would like a letter stating the Town will plow that section of road. He stated that he would donate land to build a turn around for the plow. Supervisor Marcinkowski stated it is in an open area with snow drifting bad across that section of road. The Board agreed to put that section of road on the route to plow.

The Board tabled the discussion about the Highway Department salt storage barn.

The Board granted Indian River Pop Warner the use of the ice rink for a Parent's meeting and to pass out gear on July 26th, 2015. A certificate of liability insurance has already been given to the Town.

The Supervisor told the Board that New York State DOT would not change the speed limit on NYS Route 37 by the Wilson Road for Dollar General. Also, they will not allow a driveway or second lane on NYS Route 37. The State said that it is a safety issue. Mr. Marcinkowski is scheduled to have a face to face meeting with DOT and the Governor's Office. Mr. Marcinkowski pointed out to the State that several businesses have driveways in that area. Dollar General has stated that it would bring 8 to 10 new hires to the store. The construction would be over \$700,000.00 and they would use 100 percent local contractors. The assessment for the Town would increase \$600,000.00. Supervisor Marcinkowski told the Board he is willing to bring in a TV Crew to discuss the matter.

Sara McGouch, Recreation Director, showed the Board the new uniforms for the grasshopper and peewee teams. The teams are good for coaches now. She told the Board that she only accepted cash out of concern that someone would bounce a check. She accepted a few checks for individuals she knew personally. The progress group gave \$600.00 for uniforms. Any child that can't afford fee for uniform will be paid for.

Sara told the Board that the ice rink season went well except for (1) kid drama. It was closed (2) days a week and had to close early because of frozen sewer lines. There was not Friday night recreation at the school this past season because she said it was cut out of budget.
